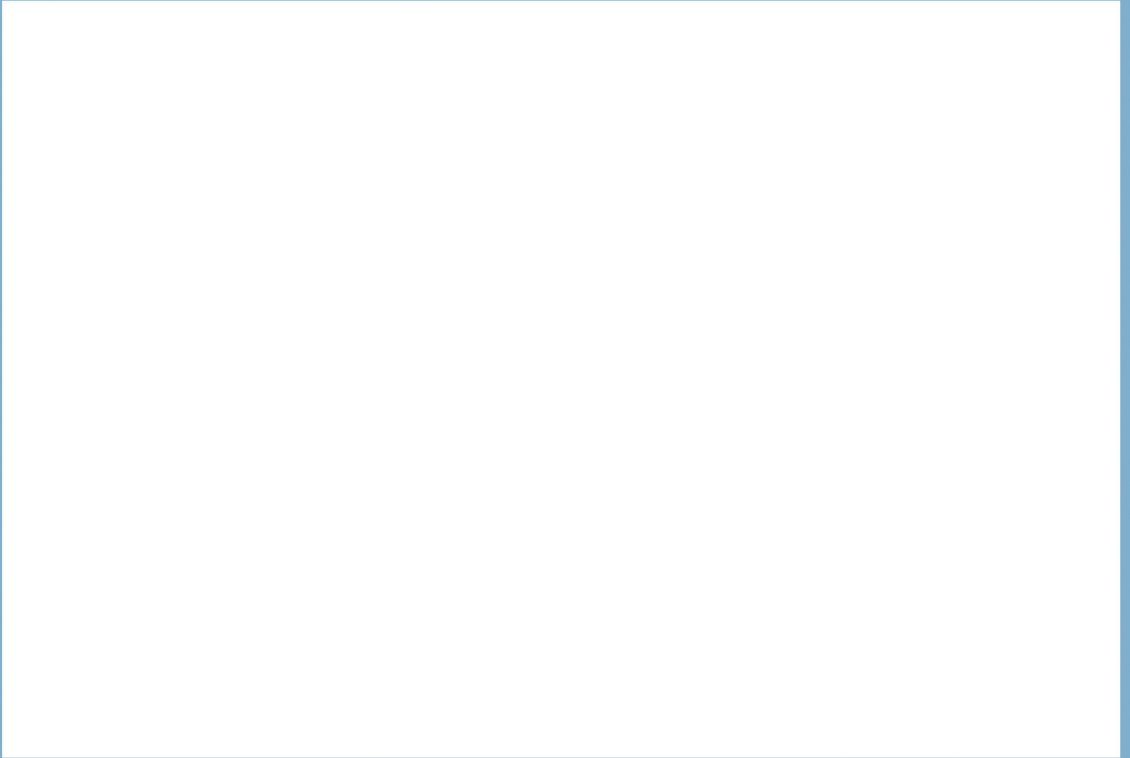
You get that feeling and then you know...

You need 2 hands to pull down your pants...

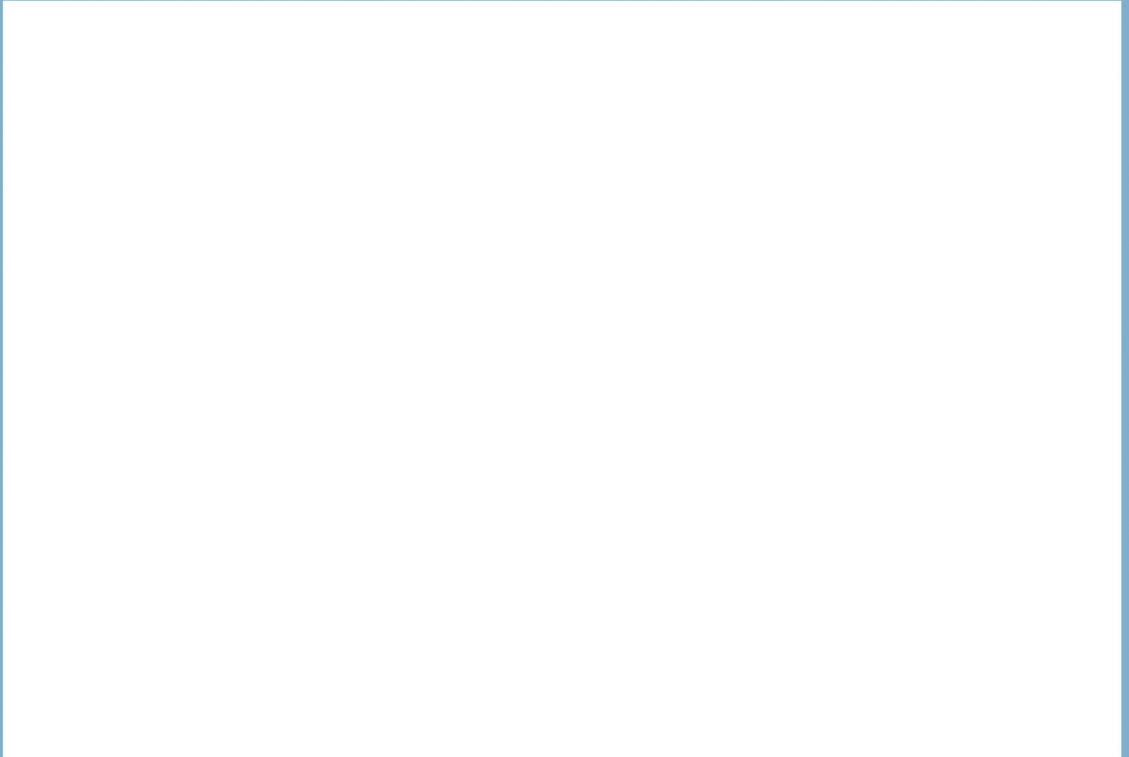


there is still so much to do.
